As discussed in last month's board meeting and in The Scoop, SCOCIA is reaching out to the community requesting neighborhood volunteers to help with some needs around the neighborhood, helping keep SCO attractive, clean and safe. If you are looking for something to do as a family, interested in meeting new people, need service hours or just interested in lending a hand to the community, please review the list provided below from our amenity managers. Be sure to also check the section, "Volunteer Corner", in the monthly edition of The Scoop for available opportunities. As a reminder: There will be **NO COST** to residents. All costs associated will be reimbursed.

Tennis:

- Assembly of 3 small (7.5 ft wide, 3 row) bleachers and transportation to new tennis pergolas.
- Bi-weekly treatment for fire ants around tennis courts and walkways (insecticide provided)
- Purchase and placement of pavers to gazebos
- Replacement of sod and/or grass seed around new gazebos
- Zip tie tennis court wind screens

Clubhouses:

- Replacement of rotten wood slats at CH2 Little Library
- Removal and donation of boxes of books from CH2 Board Room
- Removal of old ductwork and CH2 attic
- Power washing of monuments
- Installation of Nest thermostats in both clubhouses
- Gutter cleaning CH1
- Interior painting CH1

Playgrounds

- mulch refill and barrier adjustments
- power washing playground equipment

Misc:

- Fire ant treatment along gully, baseball fields and fence line along TC Jester/Fellowship Lane
- Repair/Replacement dilapidated trash receptacle containers at parks and pools
